

Trotskyist Party of Cyprus (Party)

The *Trotskyist Party of Cyprus*, was a political party active in the 1940s, probably active in Nicosia and Limassol. In contrast to AKEL, it maintained a pro-Independence line, criticizing AKEL and the broader workers' movement for its support of Enosis.
